## Overview

#### **HOW IT WORKS**

The TESOL Diploma is a combination of 9 months of a choice between online or on campus classes, and 2 weeks of assessment. The entire course is scheduled as a 12-month programme.

In the 9 months of learning we will cover 18 topics, and more. You will also begin, develop, and start to submit your coursework during this time, and will receive examination guidance.

#### **COURSE OBJECTIVES**

- An in-depth understanding of the grammatical and phonological systems of English.
- Knowledge of the main theories of teaching and how they relate to English language teaching.
- A greatly increased set of techniques that you can use in the classroom.
- Familiarity with a set of key academic texts and websites.

- 20 hours of placement, with a minimum of 10 hours practice teaching.

# MASTERS IN EDUCATION (TESOL) TEACHING ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE

This programme will give you the opportunity to discuss and debate issues related to teaching second and foreign languages. You will also develop your knowledge of how theory can inform practice in second and foreign language education. You will deepen your understanding of key concepts and ideas, and develop your ability to select, design and evaluate language teaching materials.

Students undertake modules to the value of 55 credits.

The programme consists of one core module (10 credits), one compulsory research dissertation (15 credits), and three optional modules (30 credits). Upon successful completion of 55 credits, you will be awarded a MA in Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL) In–Service.

Please note that the list of modules given here is indicative. This information is published a long time in advance of enrolment and module content and availability is subject to change.

#### **COMPULSORY MODULE**

The core module for the MA TESOL is Fundamentals of Second and Foreign Language Teaching (10 credits). Students also complete a compulsory research dissertation with guidance (15 credits).
